

Preparing for your GREAT RIVER FISHING ADVENTURE

WELCOME! Thank you for choosing Great River Fishing Adventures. We can't wait to take you out on the river to share with you our amazing fishery! In preparation please refer to this guide below and trip checklist for the information you need to be ready for your adventure.

FISHING LICENSES

By law, you **MUST** have a **PRINTED AND SIGNED COPY** of your fishing license during your fishing adventure. Digital copies are not sufficient. If you do not have your license we **CANNOT TAKE YOU FISHING** on the river.

LOCATION & DEPARTURE TIMES

All Fishing Adventures will depart at the scheduled trip times. Check your "Welcome" email for exact location. All addresses given will work in Google Maps on any device, please enter it prior to trip so it is saved and ready to go. If you are unsure of the time or location please contact your sales representative

FOOD & BEVERAGES

Fishing is thirsty work! **IF** food and non -Alcoholic beverages are not provided as a part of your fishing adventure be sure to bring your own. We provide the use of a cooler or you may bring your own small one. If you would like to arrange catered lunches for your group please speak to your sales representative prior to your adventure.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In the unlikely event that you will need to cancel your trip, your deposit is fully refundable up to 14 days prior to the start date. After which the following applies:

*An administration fee will be deducted from all refunds

*50% of the total cost of the trip will be refunded 7 to 14 days prior to the start date

*less than 7 days prior to the start date is non-refundable

*Subject to availability, your trip costs can be applied to an alternate date within the same season

TRIP CHECKLIST

- Printed and signed fishing licenses (See "Welcome" Email or Sales Rep for Info)
- Plan to arrive 10 minutes prior to your trip departure time
- Double-check and confirm your meeting location
- Load meeting location into Google Maps or GPS
- Check out your personal trip login area and share info with others in the group (See "Welcome" Email)
- Share any information or concerns that may be unique or otherwise effect your adventure with your sales representative
- Adventures paid in full 30 days prior to fishing dates. Thank you!

What to bring for your GREAT RIVER FISHING ADVENTURE

Great River Fishing can provide all fishing gear and tackle necessary for your trip. For your comfort, we advise adhering to the following guidelines regarding clothing and outerwear

SUMMER MONTHS (MAY - SEPTEMBER)

Our summer months are generally quite warm, with cooler mornings and evenings.

- Warm Layers for mornings and evenings. Synthetics and Fleece work well.
- Shorts & T-Shirts for afternoons. Quick Dry pants & shirts are great.
- Long sleeve shirts and long pants if one wishes to avoid sun.
- Sandals, hats, sunglasses & sunscreen
- Light waterproof rain jacket and pants in case it rains

FALL, WINTER, SPRING MONTHS (OCTOBER-APRIL)

Dressing up in multiple layers is most effective. Although temperatures during our winter months are usually on the mild side (up to 10+ Celsius), morning can bring frost and sometimes snow. Rule of thumb: it is better to dress warmer and shed a layer during the day than not have an extra layer to put on.

- Good waterproof rain gear as it can rain quite a bit in the fall and winter
- Several good warm layers made out of synthetics, fleece & wool are best. Avoid cottons
- Expect to wear 3-4 layers of clothing during winter
- A one-piece long underwear outfit works wonders as first layer Turtlenecks that cover the neck are really helpful.
- One lighter layer in case of nicer weather.
- Insulated hiking boots, especially when on the boat, with waterproof coating if possible.
- Sunglasses, warm toque, wool fishing gloves (5 fingers work well)
- Appropriate head gear. Wool toque to fit over a brimmed hat is ideal, remove toque if too warm, brimmed hat helps vision

- Fishing licenses – Paper copies signed and on your person (See “Welcome Email”)
- Any personal medications
- Camera or video camera – you will be gaining memories that will last a lifetime after your fishing adventure.
- Sunglasses/Sunscreen
- Brimmed Hat
- Mosquito / bug repellent
- Cooler & ice for trips planning on retaining salmon (if applicable)
- Ready to have a good time!!
